

# Central Coast Concerned Mountain Bikers Meeting Minutes

Tuesday, July 18, 2023

**I. Approval of minutes of previous meeting** - Craig motioned to approve the June 2023 monthly meeting minutes with minor changes and James seconded. All in favor.

**II. Agenda requests & introductions for any new folks.** Morris requested having input from individual board members on their role as board members, the purpose being to identify who to seek out for assistance with CCCMB tasks. ### **III. Agency and Land Manager updates and discussion as needed**

- a. El Chorro Regional Park - Jed, Christie and Frans will participate in a phone meeting on Thursday with Josh Willis of Progressive Ramps. Josh needs maps and surveys from the county. [James will get county maps and surveys for Josh.](#)
- b. LPNF and Cal Poly/West Cuesta Trails - Craig reported that he will send the soil survey and fire ring status reports by mail since he has not heard from their office. He reported that Forest Service is still working on storm damage issues. He will also create a CCCMB list of work projects for FS to review. He suggested that we could consider hosting a clean up day on TV Tower. Will discuss this more in the August monthly meeting. Craig wants to meet with Cal Poly Corporate on trail connectivity before the end of the quarter. He hasn't been able to connect with the Cal Poly cycling group for their input on our trail proposals. Craig will go ahead and meet with corporate if he hears no response from Cal Poly Cycling. Will consult with CaMTB for fundraising ideas.
- c. City of SLO - Paul reported that this week there will be a Wednesday and Saturday workdays for a new King Trail reroute in Irish Hills. Volunteers will be hand building parts of the reroute and city rangers will be using power equipment on other sections.
- d. SLO County - At Santa Margarita Lake, River Road and Blinn Ranch are now open again. Sandstone Trail is closed due to the washed out creek crossing.
- e. State Parks - Paul is still waiting for a response from Blake Thorin of State Parks to see if he can provide us a storage box to be placed by the quonset hut at Montana de Oro.
- f. LCSLO - Christie recently delivered more bells. Going forward, Morris will continue to supply decent CJ Silas with bells.

1. D&O Insurance - Christie had emailed the board to review Pachner's new offer through Arch Insurance Company for our annual coverage at a cost of \$890 for one year. Kathy made a motion to purchase the policy and Morris seconded the motion. All in favor.

2. FASTA - Christie had contacted FASTA's original members to discuss its future. No one expressed any interest in continuing that association. FASTA has no mission statement, bylaws, board or insurance apart from CCCMB. It only has a Facebook social page. For clarity, Christie made a motion to dissolve the name FASTA and Morris seconded. All in favor. Alex will be working with Niels Grether on fulfilling CCCMB's role and obligations with the City of SLO on the Eucs Grove Skills Park and for future projects and ongoing management there.
