- **I. Approval of minutes of previous meeting** Christie motioned to approve the June meeting minutes and Craig seconded the motion. All in favor.

- III. Agency and Land Manager updates and discussion as needed (30min)
 - a. SLO County
 - i. El Chorro Regional Park James is working with the County on MRS zones for the bike park. County is still determining where new buildings and roads will go. The bike park would share the parking lot, restrooms and drinking fountain. The county's plans will be coordinated with ARC. Construction costs for the bike park will be coming from road funds.
 - ii. Santa Margarita Lake Sapwi Extension trail meeting tomorrow. County is in support of contracting out the trail construction. LPFA could be a possible builder. For bridges, County needs to determine whether they will construct or contract that out.
 - b. LPNF and Cal Poly/West Cuesta Trails Craig is discussing MRS zones with the Forest Service in regard to connectivity with the El Chorro bike park. He is still waiting to hear from Cal Poly on Red Dog Connector matters. At the SLO Dirt Circus, Craig and Christie met Kailyn Claire Ray. She is mapping out trails for Cal Poly and Craig is now working with her. He has also been adding trails and updating maps on the Trailforks app.
 - c. City of SLO Niels reported by email that grading and reroute of the main fire road up from the Marsh St. parking lot is nearly complete. Phase 1 of the Laguna Lake Bike Park is also being finished up. Numerous other trail projects are in the works.
 - d. State Parks Brushing work continues on Fridays at Montana de Oro. Jim is brushing some trail sections at Cerro Cabrillo and he is working on ordering new trail junction signs in both parks.
 - e. LCSLO At Pismo Preserve, the Freedom Trax work was completed. Scott Couture is delivering some rock to the Thursday trail crew to replace some rotting wooden berm supports on some switchback turns.
