 - ii. Sapwi Trail Craig reported that SLO County will contract out the completion of the work necessary to complete the extension of the Sapwi trail. CCCMB had a meeting with County rangers, Slopost and Atascadero Horsemen are both willing to make a donation. SLO County will also look for funds. CCCMB will wait for a quote on the project before making a donation to it. Also look for a grant possibly. The County has public contract builders. Craig has provided the County with preengineered plans for bridges on multiuser trails. Scott Couture might bid on the the project.
 - b. LPNF and Cal Poly/West Cuesta Trails Craig reported that Rinconada Trail has been approved for trail maintenance and that Backcountry Horsemen will lead a workday in the future. The FS will move forward with the West Cuesta Sustainable Trail Project. It's expected to be approved late this year or early 2025. The TV Tower road project will be done separately and will take longer. Ben Gray suggested that we contact Camp San Luis to allow use of existing trails. Craig will invite Ben to our meeting. Cal Poly wants to do trails an alternative to Red Dog and an extension down to El Chorro Park. Craig will reach out to Ken Kenow to find an Army contact person.
